Life Groups Are Important Because...

- They move us out of self-centered isolation. It's a place for learning how to get along in God's family, practicing unselfish, sympathetic love, as you learn to care about others and share the experiences of others.
- They help us develop spiritual muscle. "As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love".
- They confirm our identity as genuine believers.

 Jesus said, "Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples" (John 13:35 NLT). When we come together in love as a small group from different backgrounds, ethnicities, and social statuses, it's a witness to the world.
- They are a great way to share our God-given mission in the world. When Jesus walked the earth, even he had a small group! He works through us in the world. "He creates each of us by Christ Jesus to join him in the work he does, the good work he has gotten ready for us to do, work we had better be doing" (Ephesians 2:10 MSG).
- They help keep us from spiritually backsliding. None of us are immune to temptation. Given the right situation, you and I are capable of any sin. God knows this, so he has assigned us as individuals the responsibility of keeping each other on track. The Bible says, "Encourage one another daily ... so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness" (Hebrews 3:13).
