Ministry/Missions

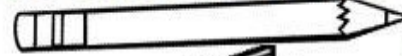
I pray that You will make _____'s ministry exceedingly fruitful and that You will glorify Yourself through this ministry (2 Thess. 3:1).

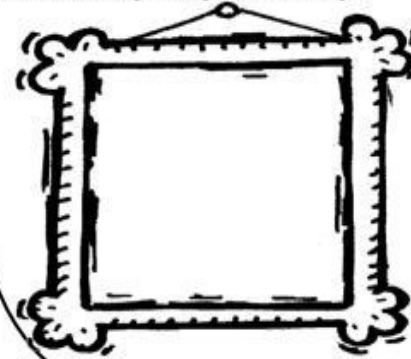

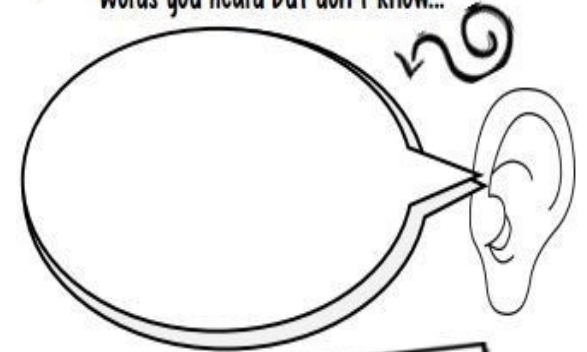
