Dr. Kent Anderson came to Providence after 26 years at Northwest Baptist Seminary in Langley, BC, where he served as president and professor of preaching. He is a leader in theological education, serving on several national boards and helping lead Symporus, which supports Christian schools. He is known for developing a practical, skill-based approach to ministry training and has a new book coming soon. Dr. Anderson has 12 years of pastoral experience, has preached worldwide, and has written four books on preaching, including Integrative Preaching. He holds a PhD from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.
