We have most of chapters 1-11 drafted and we meet as a team every morning to edit the first drafts together. We did a community check on chapter 1 in March and April. Everyone who heard the recording wanted to hear more! Now we are using their feedback to edit again. Please pray for all these different steps in the process!

In July and August, Kara (along with Moses, almost 14) is planning to be in the Mountain language area for about 3 weeks. Pray for good progress on the work and good connection with people in the community. Please also pray for safety in travel and in the time spent in the mountains. A new concern this trip is the conflict in the Middle East, which upsets this language group very much and also makes it harder for them to understand the message of forgiveness and peace that we are translating.
